

Prospectus – Community Trust Bank National Tennis Art Exhibition 2007

Categories

Only Tennis related themes in the following categories will be accepted:

1. Oil and Acrylic
 2. Watercolor, 2-D Mixed Media, Pen & Ink
 3. Drawing (Graphite, Charcoal and Pastels)
 4. Photography and Computer Graphics
 5. Sculpture, New Media and 3-D Mixed Media
- Examples of New Media would be a short video piece (less than five minutes) or a time based artwork.*

No crafts will be accepted.

Eligibility

Open to all artists residing in the U.S. All submitted work must be original and executed within the last two years (2005-2007). Artwork which was entered in previous Community Trust Bank Tennis Art Exhibitions will not be accepted.

Entry Fee

A non-refundable fee of \$25 for up to three entries must accompany the entry form. Make check payable to DKM Sports. *Additional entries in increments up to 3 may be submitted for an extra \$25. For example, the entry fee for 4 to 6 pieces is \$50; the fee for 7 to 9 pieces is \$75.*

Entry Procedure

The completed entry form and entry fee, along with a 5"x7" photograph of each entry or a digital image of each entry saved onto a CD, must be received by **July 31, 2007**. Do not fold photos. Please write on the envelope "Photos - Do Not Bend." If you send digital images they should be saved as JPEGs and burned onto a Microsoft compatible CD. Image size should be no greater than 2 MB each. Each 3D piece may be represented by two photos shot from different angles (digital or 5"x7" print). Please include a self-addressed, stamped postcard for notification of juror's decision. The juror will have final authority to define what constitutes an acceptable entry. Notification of the juror's decision will be mailed by August 6, 2007. No photos or CD's will be returned.

Juror: Brad McCombs

McCombs currently lives in Ironton, Ohio and teaches at Ohio University as coordinator of the art program on the Southern Campus. McCombs' role as an artist is comprehensive and embraces: activism, anthropology, ecology, and sociology. He uses a broad range of materials and works in many mediums, which enable his conceptually driven works to become fully realized. Using these interests he weaves cross-cultural and interdisciplinary elements into a cohesive web. McCombs has shown both nationally and internationally with exhibits at the Gallery Project (Ann Arbor, MI), The Lab (San Francisco, CA), Los Angeles Contemporary Exhibitions (Los Angeles, CA), The Mockbee (Cincinnati, OH), SPACELab (Cleveland, OH), The Carnegie (Covington, KY), Nukuyawani Outpost (Ngau, Fiji Islands), the International Arts Festival (Chania, Greece), Cité Internationale des Arts (Paris, France), the Urban Institute of Contemporary Art (Grand Rapids, MI), a public artwork with the Seattle Arts Commission (Seattle, WA), and an upcoming solo exhibition at Hanover College (Hanover, IN).

Purchase Awards

Purchase awards will be given in the following amounts:

- One **Best of Show** Award of **\$1000** (This award will be selected by Dr. Jack Ditty)
- Five **First Place** Awards of **\$800** each (total: \$4000)
- Five **Second Place** Awards of **\$600** each (total: \$3000)
- Five **Third Place** Awards of **\$400** each (total: \$2000)

Artwork receiving the above awards will become the property of DKM Sports. It is intended that the award-winning pieces will be included in a travelling collection of tennis-related art.

Pieces priced above \$400 will not be considered for entry into the show.

Artists will retain reproduction rights of all works.

Sale of Artwork

Sale of artworks will be encouraged and a 30% commission will be charged. Local and state

taxes will be subtracted and a check will be issued to the artist as soon as possible. Artists will state the retail price of their works. Pricing may not be changed after the work is received.

Accepted Work

If your work is accepted, notification will be posted by August 6, 2007, and you should ship the work to the Pendleton Art Center in time to be received no later than August 20 or hand deliver on Saturday, August 18 between the hours of 10:00 am to 4:00 pm or Monday, August 20, 2007 between the hours of 2:00 to 6:00 pm.

All works must be insured and all shipping and return-shipping postage prepaid. Works must be received by August 20, 2007. Accepted entries will be on display at The Ann Davis Gallery from Friday, September 7 to Monday, October 1, 2007.

2D work must be suitably framed, wired (no metal hooks) and ready for hanging or otherwise suitably prepared for exhibition. Maximum size for two-dimensional work is 48" x 60". Maximum weight 20 lbs. Only Plexiglas accepted on 2D works.

3D work such as sculpture must meet the following guidelines: Minimum size is 4" wide x 4" deep x 12" tall, unless mounted under Plexiglas and ready to hang for wall display; Maximum size is 24" x 24" x 24". 3D pieces weighing over 20 lbs. must be installed by artist with the installation approved by the director of the Ann Davis Gallery. The Ann Davis Gallery and DKM Sports reserve the right to exclude any entry that presents complex installation problems, or is unsuitably prepared for hanging or installation.

Return of Artwork

All local artwork must be picked up by Monday, October 1, 2007 after 2:00 pm at The Ann Davis Gallery and before 6:00 pm. National works will be returned promptly. All works must have return shipping prepaid by the artist or the pieces will not be included in the exhibit.

Liability and Agreement

All accepted artwork must remain on display from September 7 through October 1, 2007 at The Ann Davis Gallery.

The Ann Davis Gallery and DKM Sports shall have the right to use photographs of accepted work for promotional purposes. The Ann Davis Gallery and DKM Sports will take all due care in the safekeeping of the artwork which is submitted for competition and show, but will not be responsible for damaged works beyond that care and consideration. Furthermore, The Ann Davis Gallery and DKM Sports cannot pay transportation or shipping fees to and from the gallery. All shipped artwork must have a prepaid return shipping label.

Artwork not sold will be shipped immediately after the closing of the show. The Ann Davis Gallery will not be responsible for work left on premises beyond the pick-up date listed in the calendar. Submission of work will constitute an agreement to comply with all conditions set forth in this prospectus. The Ann Davis Gallery and DKM Sports reserve the right to reject any work not in keeping with the Gallery's standards concerning taste.

Television Exhibition

The entire exhibition will be filmed and exhibited on the Television program "Your Health with Dr. Ditty" on Daystar Network in southern Ohio, West Virginia, and eastern Kentucky. A copy of the television program will be available for \$20. Call Daystar at 606-329-2700 to order.
